








## Camilla Parker Bowles reveals the Royal Family were worried over Meghan Markle family drama before royal wedding

Harry, begging him not to marry 'jaded' Meghan and calling the wedding a 'mistake', her father pulled out of attending just two days before the wedding day.


As well as her brother penning a scathing open letter to Prince

A minute's silence was held at a garden party last year for the 22 victims who were killed and those who were injured when a suicide bomb was detonated after an Ariana Grande concert on May 22.

More than 6,000 people from 386 of the charities Charles supports in celebration of his patronage work were also in attendance too.


It marked Harry and Meghan's first royal engagement as a married couple.




