SIMPLIFIED SELECTION PROCESS TO HIRE VISITING PROFESSORS

The President of the *Universidade Federal de Pelotas* (UFPEL), exercising the power conferred upon him by law, discloses to the public the call dedicated to select applicants by means of a simplified selection process to hire visiting Brazilian or foreign professors in accordance with Law No. 8745/1993 and its amendments, Resolution No. 035/2017 - UFPEL and remunerations as per Article 4, Paragraph 2 of the Policy Guidance SRH/MP No. 5/2009, as described below:

1. APPLICATIONS

1.1. The applications for the simplified selection process will be open to the position of Visiting Professor (Brazilian or foreign) as per Articles 9 and 10 of COCEPE Resolution No. 035/2017:

a) **Visiting Professor 1:** for PhD holders who have at least 10 years of proven academic, scientific or technical/professional experience counting from the date their PhD was earned. Working hours: 40 hours a week. Remuneration: compatible with Level E, as per Article 4, Paragraph 2 of the Policy Guidance SRH/MP No. 5/2009.

b) **Visiting Professor 2:** for PhD holders who have up to 5 years of proven academic, scientific or technical/professional experience counting from the date their PhD was earned. Working hours: 40 hours a week. Remuneration: compatible with Level D1, as per Article 4, Paragraph 2 of the Policy Guidance SRH/MP No. 5/2009.

c) **Foreign Professors:** for PhD holders who have proven academic, scientific or technical/professional experience. Working hours: 40 hours a week. Remuneration: compatible with Level E, as per Article 4, Paragraph 2 of the Policy Guidance SRH/MP No. 5/2009.

1.2. Application period: **April 17 to May 31, 2018**, from 12 to 6 pm, at the PRPPGI Office (Rua Gomes Carneiro, 01, Sala 409, Bloco A- Centro, Pelotas - RS, CEP 96010-610) or via e-mail: visitantes.ufpel@gmail.com.

1.2.1. For applications submitted by e-mail, candidates must identify the program they are applying to by writing the following in the field "SUBJECT" of their message: VISITING PROFESSOR APPLICATION: GRADUATE PROGRAM IN <NAME OF THE PROGRAM>.

1.2.2. The applications submitted by e-mail must meet the same deadline (date and time) of those applications handed in in person. It will be taken into account the time the e-mail was received based on Brasília official time.

1.2.3 Applications will be considered valid only when they follow the guidelines expressed in item 1.2.

1.3 In order to apply, candidates must send the following documents: the application form (ANNEX 1), the receipt regarding the application fee obtained by paying the GRU (Federal Tax Liability Payment Form) and the documents supporting/evidencing the candidate's scientific production.

1.3.1. Copies of book covers, summaries and first pages of chapters or papers, as well as Digital Object Identifiers (where applicable), will be accepted as supporting documents for scientific production relating to papers and chapters.

1.3.2. Application fee: R\$ 191.40 (one hundred ninety-one reais and forty cents). The GRU to pay the application fee can be generated by accessing http://consulta.tesouro.fazenda.gov.br/gru_simples.asp and entering the following information:

1.3.3. Applications will be DISQUALIFIED if: they are submitted after the deadline; the amount paid for the application fee is lower than that established in this public call or if applicants disrespect the form of payment established in this call.

1.4. It is mandatory that candidates choose the area they are applying to according to the table of vacancies established in this call. Candidates will not be allowed to change their area after submitting their application.

1.5. Candidates can apply for more than one vacancy, but they must choose only one of them in case they are selected.

1.6. All fields of the application form must be filled out. Applicants are entirely responsible for incomplete or illegible information provided.

1.6.1. It is mandatory that candidates inform the electronic address of their Curriculum Lattes. Their Curriculum Lattes must be updated.

1.6.2. In the case of non-Brazilian candidates applying for the Foreign Visiting Professor vacancies, the Curriculum Vitae must be submitted or sent together with the documentation described in 1.3.

1.6.1.1 . After selection and admission, non-Brazilian candidates approved in the Selective Process must generate their curricula in the Lattes platform so they can be linked to research groups and other actions sponsored by research funding institutions.

1.7. Applications will only be valid upon the payment of the GRU and handing in/submission of the application. The data printed on the GRU must be checked beforehand and, in the event of divergences, a new invoice must be printed. Once the payment has been made, there can be no changes or updates of the requested data. This will only be possible upon the payment of a new application fee.

1.8. The GRU and its receipt of payment must be kept with the candidate. Bank payment schedules will not be accepted as receipts. Payments whose invoice is not the one generated by the application system of this Simplified Selection Process will not be accepted.

1.8.1. The Dean's Office for Research, Graduate Programs and Innovation (PRPPGI) will not be liable for application requests not received via internet due to any technical malfunction of computers, communication failures, congestion of communication lines, error, delay or strikes by banks or contracted entities in charge of processing the payment of the application fees, as well as any other technical reasons preventing the transfer of data.

1.9. Under no circumstances applications will be accepted either conditionally or after the deadline, nor there will be a refund of the application fee, except in case the Simplified Selection Process is cancelled. Conditional applications, applications via fax, e-mail or after the deadline are not permitted.

1.10. Candidates must verify the confirmation of their application in the Simplified Selection Process after three (3) working days from the application fee payment by checking our homepage: <https://wp.ufpel.edu.br/prppgi>. A LIST WITH THE NAMES OF ALL APPLICANTS WILL BE DISCLOSED ON THE PRPPGI WEBSITE AFTER THE CLOSING OF THE ANNOUNCED DEADLINE.

1.11. In the event that a candidate cannot confirm his/her application or does not find his/her name on the list until the third business day after its disclosure, he/she should request PRPPGI to include his/her name among the other applicants. For this purpose, he/she must present a receipt of payment of the application fee (as well as the GRU). This request must be made in person or by e-mail (visitantes.ufpel@gmail.com) by sending, upon request, a certified copy of the GRU and its respective receipt by SEDEX (or any other form of Express

1.11.1. Applicants are entirely responsible for monitoring this process as well as any problems regarding their application. No information in candidates' applications will be modified or corrected after the deadline announced for the request of this action.

1.12. Applying to this Simplified Selection Process implies, from the outset, candidates' awareness and tacit acceptance of the conditions established in this call for applications and its Annexes, in addition to the conditions determined by Law No. 12772/2012 (published in the Official Federal Gazette on 31/12/2012), Law No. 8745/1993 (published in the Official Federal Gazette on 10/12/1993) and Resolution No. 035/2017-UFPEL, of which they cannot plead ignorance.

1.13. PRRPPGI is in charge of ratifying the applications and appointing the examination committee. All the information regarding this process will be published at <https://wp.ufpel.edu.br/prppgi> as soon as they are known.

2. RESERVATION OF VACANCIES FOR THE DISABLED

2.1. Disabled people who wish to benefit from the right granted upon them according to Article 37, section VIII of the Brazilian Constitution, Law No. 7853/89 and Decree No. 3289/99 are entitled to apply to this selection process provided that the job description of the intended position is compatible with the candidate's disability.

2.1.1. Five percent (5%) of the vacancies offered in this selection process will be reserved for the disabled, as per Article 37 of Decree No. 3298/1999.

2.1.2. In the event of a fractional number results from the 5% (five percent) applied over the total number of vacancies, it must be raised to the first subsequent whole number as long as it does not exceed twenty percent (20%) of the total vacancies, as per Article 5, Paragraph 2, Law No. 8122/1990.

2.1.3. Five percent (5%) of the vacancies are reserved for candidates who declare themselves disabled, provided that they compulsorily submit a medical report (original document or notarized copy) meeting the following requirements: a) it must have been issued up to 180 (one hundred and eighty) days counting from the beginning of the application period; b) it must describe the kind and degree of the disability; c) it must present the probable cause of the disability, in accordance with the law; d) it must include a reference to the corresponding International Classification of Diseases (ICD) code in force; e) it must state whether orthodontics, prostheses or adaptations are used; f) in the case of hearing impairment, the report must be accompanied by a recent audiometry issued up to 180 (one hundred and

eighty) days counting from the beginning of the application period; g) in the case of visually impairment, the report must be accompanied by a visual acuity test of both eyes, pathology and visual field; h) in the case of mental disability, the report must include the date of illness onset, associated limitation areas and adapted skills; i) in the case of multiple disabilities, the report must include the association of two or more disabilities.

2.1.4. Candidates who wish to apply for vacancies reserved for the disabled must choose this option upon application and send the medical report (original or notarized copy), as established in 2.1.3, until the deadline of the application period.

2.1.5. PRPPGI reserves the right to preliminarily reject requests submitted after the established deadline or containing incomplete documentation.

2.1.6. Disabled candidates subjected to the special conditions under Decree No. 2998/99 will participate in the simplified selection process on equal terms with the other candidates with respect to the content of the tests, evaluation, criteria for approval, timetable and place of the tests, as well as the minimum passing grades required.

2.1.7. Disabled candidates must declare their condition upon application, specifying the kind of disability they have, in compliance with Article 4 of Decree No. 3298 /1999.

2.1.8. Candidates who upon application do not declare themselves disabled and/or do not submit the requested documentation supporting their condition will lose the prerogative to compete as disabled people.

2.1.9. By applying as disabled and submitting a medical report, by no means candidates guarantee their automatic participation in the competition for the reserved vacancies. Their medical report must undergo a medico-legal expert or equivalent body; where an application for disability is rejected, candidates will only be able to compete for the intended position as a regular applicant.

2.1.10. Should the medico-legal expert or equivalent body recognize any incompatibility between the kind of disability and the position to be occupied or the non-compliance with the provisions of Article 4 of Decree No. 2998/99, the candidate will not be considered able to take office and will fall within the general classification, competing with the other candidates without disabilities.

2.2. Disabled candidates who upon application do not choose this option and do not comply with what has been established by this call will have their application processed as a regular candidate. Also, they will not be able to allege such a condition and claim legal support afterwards. Candidates who fail to deliver the medical report within the deadline cannot file an appeal in their favor.

3. RESERVATION OF VACANCIES FOR BLACK PEOPLE

3.1. The percentage of vacancies intended for black people complies with the criteria established by Law No. 12990/2014.

3.2. For the purposes of Law No. 12990/2014, those candidates who declare themselves black upon application in this selection process can compete for the vacancies reserved for the black, in accordance with the category of color or race used by the Brazilian Institute of Geography and Statistics (IBGE).

3.2.1. For the purposes of this simplified selection process, no distinction will be made between black people through the signed self-declaration.

3.2.2. The self-declaration will be valid only if made upon application and cannot be used for other processes of any kind whatsoever.

3.3. The equivalent to 20% (twenty percent) of the total vacancies will be reserved for self-declared candidates, pursuant to Law No. 12990 /2014.

3.3.1. In the event of a fractional number higher or equal to 0.5 (five tenths) results from the percentage of 20% applied over the total number of vacancies reserved for the black, the immediate following whole number will be used; should the fractional number be lower than 0.5 (five tenths), the next whole lower number will be used.

3.3.2. In case there are not enough self-declared black passing candidates to fill the vacancies reserved for this purpose, the remaining vacancies will be used to be distributed among the other regular passing candidates, observing the ranking order.

3.3.3. The appointments of the passing candidates will follow the criteria of alternance and proportionality, which take into account the relationship between the total number of vacancies and the number of vacancies reserved for the self-declared candidates.

3.4. Applicants who intend to compete for the vacancies reserved for the black must select this option upon application and submit the self-declaration form available for this selection process at <http://concursos.ufpel.edu.br/wp/formularios> within the deadline established by PRPPGI. Candidates who do not select this option upon registration cannot file an appeal in their favor. Documents can be sent by post to PRÓ-REITORIA DE PESQUISA, PÓS-GRADUAÇÃO E INOVAÇÃO DA UFPel - Edital CPG 2/2018 - PRPPGI/UFPel - Pelotas - RS) or by e-mail (visitantes.ufpel@gmail.com).

3.5. In compliance with the Policy Guidance No. 3/2016 passed by the Ministry of Planning and Development, self-declared candidates will have their ethnicity attested by attending an interview. This interview will be called by a Special Committee appointed by Ordinance No. 825/2017 and will have decision-making competence to verify candidates' phenotypic

features. The schedule of the interviews will be published on the homepage of this simplified selection process.

3.5.1. Candidates will be photographed and their interviews will be filmed for registration and evaluation upon their express permission.

3.6. The decisions made by the above mentioned Committee can be appealed. Should that be the case, appeals must be submitted/presented within two (02) business days counting from the disclosure of the evaluation results to:

visitantes.ufpel@gmail.com. No new appeals can be filed after the judgment of this first appeal.

3.7. In the event of false self-declarations, candidates will be disqualified from the selection process. Should they have been appointed to their position, they will be subjected to the annulment of their admission to the public service or employment after undergoing an administrative legal process. Candidates are granted the right of defense and a fair hearing without prejudice to other applicable measures.

3.8. Candidates who do not attend the interview or who do not qualify as black by the Committee will be eliminated from the simplified selection process.

3.9. Candidates are solely and exclusively liable for all the information provided upon their application.

3.10. In the event of withdrawal of a passing black candidate for a reserved vacancy, this vacancy will be filled by the next classified black candidate of the ranking.

3.11. Results will be published in two specific lists. The first list will inform the score of all passing candidates (regular and self-declared ones). The second list will inform just the score of the passing candidates who applied for the quota reserved for black people.

4. EXAMINATION COMMITTEE

4.1. The General Examination Committee will be consisted of full time professors appointed by the Vice Presidency for Research, Graduate Studies and Innovation (PRPPGI).

5. THE SELECTION PROCESS

5.1. Candidates will be selected on the basis of a simplified process consisting of two phases:

5.1.1. The first phase of the public selection (eliminary round) will consist of the assessment of competence recognition.

a) Candidates' competence recognition will be verified through their academic production in terms of its relevance and compatibility with the Research Productivity Fellows (PQ or DT), according to the requirements established by the Assessment Criteria of CNPq Advisory Committees.

b) In the event there is no Assessment Criteria established by CNPq Advisory Committees for the area in which the selective process is intended, Assessment Criteria of related areas will be used.

c) The Assessment Criteria of CNPq Advisory Committees that will be used by each area covered in this call are available at <http://cnpq.br/criterios-de-julgamento>.

5.1.2. Candidates meeting the criteria for the assessment of competence recognition will be classified for the second phase of the selection. The remaining candidates will be eliminated from the selection process.

5.1.3. The second phase of the public selection (eliminary and qualifying round) will consist of the analysis of candidates' production based on the Assessment Criteria of CNPq Advisory Committees.

a) Candidates' scientific production will be analyzed on the basis of supporting evidence (Curriculum Vitae and the Template for Curriculum Scoring with supporting documents) of the last 5 (five) full years, all of which must be submitted by the candidate within the deadline described in item 1 of this call.

b) Curriculum and documents proving the regularity of the candidates' activities will be analyzed aiming the consolidation and internationalization of Master's and Doctoral programs on the basis of the following items and with a score based on the Template for Curriculum Scoring found in Annex II:

I. Teaching activities in Master's and Doctoral Programs;

II. Scientific/Technological production;

III. Training and mentoring of Master's and Doctoral students;

IV. Research projects approved by research funding institutions.

After the evaluation of the Examination Committee, a maximum score 10 (considered the reference score and called Maximum Curriculum Scoring) will be given to the highest score obtained among candidates. The other candidates will be given a score proportional to the Maximum Curriculum Scoring.

5.1.4. Applicants who do not achieve the minimum passing grade will be eliminated from the selective process.

6. RESULTS

6.1. The ranking of applicants will follow a descending order based on the final grade and will take into account the minimum passing grade 7.0 (seven).

6.2. This public call will allocate 01 (one) vacancy for each Graduate Program. The maximum number of candidates classified for each vacancy will follow what is established in Annex II of Decree No. 6944/2009, as shown in the following table:

6.3. Candidates who have reached the minimum passing grade but are not classified within the maximum number of passing applicants referred to in the previous sub item, will automatically fail the public selection (as established by Decree No. 6944/2009).

6.4. In the case of a tie in the final grade, the candidate aged sixty or older by the end of the applications deadline will be given priority, in compliance with Paragraph One of One of the Article 27 of Law No. 10741/2005 (Senior Citizen Statute).

6.4.1 Should there be more than one candidate aged sixty or older, the older candidate will be given priority.

6.5. After being disclosed in a public session, the result of this public selection will be published in an easily accessible place to everyone in the office responsible for this selection process and also at UFPel website.

7. APPEALING THE RESULTS

7.1. Once the results have been published at UFPel website, candidates will have up to 3 (three) business days to question their assessments by filing a request properly addressed to the coordinator of the office responsible for the selection. Candidates can submit a request of their assessment either in person or by mail.

7.2. The Examination Committee will have up to 3 (three) business days to analyze the requests before announcing its decision on the appeals.

8. CONFIRMATION OF RESULTS

Once the result of this selection process has been sent to the institutional office in charge of public tenders, it will be confirmed by the Vice Presidency of Research, Graduate Studies and Innovation (PRPPGI) and by the Education, Research and Extension Council so the appropriate administrative actions can be taken.

9. REMUNERATION

9.1. According to UFPEL's Resolution No. 35/2017, the remuneration of visiting professors will be as follows:

- Visiting Professor 1: for PhD holders with a minimum of 10 (ten) years of proven academic, scientific or technical-professional experience counting from the date they earned that degree, with remuneration equivalent to Level E.
- Visiting Professor 2: for PhD holders with up to 5 (five) years of proven academic, scientific or technical-professional experience counting from the date they earned that degree, with remuneration equivalent to Level D1.
- Foreign professors with proven academic, scientific or technical, professional experience counting from the date they earned that degree, with remuneration equivalent to Level E (corresponding to the wages of a full professor).

9.2. In compliance with Law No. 12772/2012, monthly wages will be a sum of the basic salary and an extra bonus due to academic curriculum/qualification.

10. DURATION OF THE CONTRACT

- Brazilian visiting professors: initial contract of up to 12 (twelve) months, which may be extended for an equal period;

- Foreign visiting professors: initial contract of up to 24 (twenty-four) months, which may be extended for an equal period;

11. EXPIRY DATE OF THE SIMPLIFIED SELECTION PROCESS

This simplified selection process will be valid for one (1) year counting from the date the results confirmation is published in the National Official Gazette (DOU). It may be extended for an equal period upon request of the Coordination of Graduate Studies.

12. FINAL PROVISIONS

12.1. Applicants' participation in the selection process implies, from the outset, the knowledge and tacit agreement of the conditions established in the entire content of this public call and other regulation procedures of this public session.

12.2. Only candidates who have previously developed activities based on Law No. 8745/1993 and whose working contracts have expired more than 24 months ago can be hired.

12.3. Only foreign applicants who present a permanent visa in Brazil on the date of signing the contract or those who present a temporary visa as scientists, researchers, professors, technicians or professionals of another category under contract or at the service of the Brazilian government can be hired (in compliance with Law No. 6815/1980).

12.4. Under the provisions of this law, it is forbidden the hiring of employees working for other Brazilian public administration departments, states, cities, as well as employees or servants of their subsidiaries and controlled corporations.

12.5. Candidates applying for visiting professor vacancies who happen to be retired servers will not be admitted to work in the same university where they retired from (as per Article 6, item I of Resolution No. 035/2017 - UFPEL).
